



DIY hand moisturizer



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what you will need

- 25g cacao butter
- 20g shea butter
- 5g cold-pressed oils (eg hemp oil, rosehip oil, almond oil, sunflower oil)
- 2g beeswax
- alcohol in a spray bottle
- 2 drops of essential oils (eg francinsense, lavender, cedar oil)

utensils

- a pot
- a heat resisting jar (old marmelade/jam glas)
- spoons
- 1 small cup
- scale
- jar for the moisturizer (50ml)





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let's start creating :)

- first, all tools, cups and jars must be disinfected with alcohol
- then fill a small pot halfway with water and heat it up
- while weighing the beeswax, cocoa butter and shea butter in a heat-resistant container
- place the jar in a water bath and let the contents melt
- take it out of the water bath and let it cool down a little
- drop in the essential oils and pour them into the jar
- don't forget to label it :)
